TOWN SERVICES

Yarmouth citizens are proud of their town and value its high level of municipal services and quality of life. Citizens and town officials have worked together to update the Comprehensive Plan to guide decision making as the town continues to grow and diversify. Our town is governed by the Town Manager and a seven-member Town Council, which meets the first and third Thursday of each month. Numerous Boards and Committees



address issues regarding zoning, education, and other town business.

The Town Office, located on Main Street, is home to the Town Manager's Office, Town Clerk, Planning Office, Tax Assessor, Engineer, Public Works Director and Community Services.

The Merrill Memorial Library offers reading material of all types; audio/visual material, computer and internet access, children's story hour and summer reading programs.

Recycling and refuse removal are based out of the Transfer Station on outer East Main Street. Residents can obtain a Transfer Station Sticker for their vehicle at the Town Office.

GETTING HERE

FROM THE NORTH (GARDINER AND POINTS NORTH)

- I-95 (ME Turnpike) south to Gardiner where the highway splits
- Exit 103 to I-295 South
- I-295 toward Portland
- Exit 17 to US-1 toward Yarmouth

FROM THE SOUTH (PORTLAND)

- I-295 toward Falmouth
- Exit 15 to US-1 toward Yarmouth/Cumberland
- Keep right at the fork in the ramp
- Merge onto US-1

FROM THE WEST (GRAY)

Route 115 east (becomes Main Street in Yarmouth)

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FROM BOSTON

Amtrak's Downeaster and Concord Coach Lines — both very comfortable and pleasant — will get you to Portland, where taxis are available for the 15-minute, 10-mile trip to Yarmouth.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FROM GREATER PORTLAND

The METRO BREEZ, part of Greater Portland METRO, provides express bus service to Yarmouth. Service is available from the Portland Transportation Center and downtown Portland. For more information, schedules, and rates, call METRO BREEZ at (207) 774-0351 or visit www.gpmetro.org.



PARKING

VISITOR PARKING

Free parking lots are available at most businesses and retail locations in Yarmouth.

In the village, parking is available along Main Street, next to Latchstring Park at the corner of West Elm and Main Street, and off of Mill Street behind 317 Main Street. For any questions on parking, please contact the Yarmouth Police Department (207) 846-3333.

Yarmouth will be experiencing Main Street improvements from West Elm to South Street during the 2021 Spring and Summer months. Businesses are open to the public. Please make sure to look for way-finding signage for changes in parking and for safe entry to business locations.

DISABILITY PARKING

Available in designated areas in lots and along Main Street. Locations are marked by signage.

OVERNIGHT PARKING

In Village

Street parking is available overnight between April 15 and November 15, as long as no sign or ordinance prohibits. There is a winter overnight parking ban on all streets from November 15 through April 15.

At Town Landing

No overnight parking at the Town Landing off Old Shipyard Road, at the Madeleine Point mooring area parking lot, Sandy Point Beach parking area, on or along Old Town Landing Road, or the Littlejohn Island dock area. An overnight parking permit may be obtained from the Harbormaster or his/her designated agent during normal business hours. For additional information on Town Landing parking restrictions, please call the Yarmouth Police Department at (207) 846-3333.

RV PARKING

For information on RV parking, please contact Town Hall at (207) 846-9036.

TOUR BUS PARKING

Tour buses are welcome to drop off passengers in front of Town Hall (200 Main Street). While passengers are enjoying their time in Yarmouth, we ask that bus drivers' stage at the Park and Ride lot located at the Maine Visitor Information Center, 1100 U.S. Route 1.

YARMOUTH POLICE DEPARTMENT

YARMOUTH FIRE RESCUE

Yarmouth Fire Rescue provides emergency response to our community and its mutual-aid partners. Our services include:

- Fire suppression
- Emergency medical transport (with Advanced Life Support capabilities)
- Life Safety Inspections and Public Education Programs

We are staffed by a full-time Fire Rescue Chief, Deputy Chief, and Career Paramedic Firefighters, who are supplemented by per-diem and volunteer call staff.

NEW PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING

A new Public Safety Building is home to both Fire Rescue and the Police Department. It is now open, operational, and located at 178 North Road in Yarmouth.

The Yarmouth Economic Development Advisory Board (EDAB) was constituted as a “Brain Trust” and advocacy and advisory citizen’s committee for Yarmouth with a commitment to expand the Town’s economic, cultural, and civic bases to achieve economic stability through growth, diversity, and quality development,

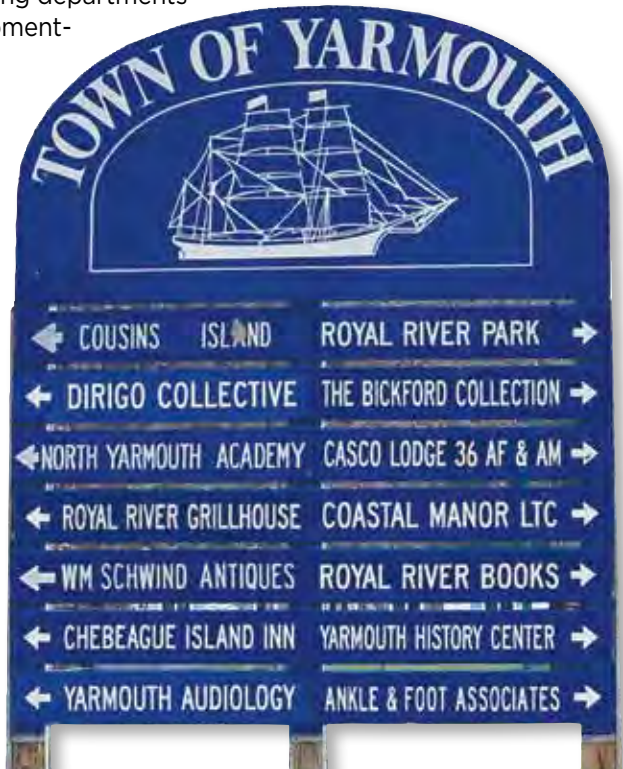


together with providing a positive local climate to attract targeted business, trade, arts, services, people, and industry to our community. Since establishing in 2015, the Board has worked collaboratively with the Town’s Economic Development Director to create policies and growth initiatives which are charting Yarmouth’s future. Some of those growth initiatives include the completion of a robust Townwide market analysis and economic development strategy, commissioning a study to evaluate parking needs on Main Street and working with the Town’s code enforcement and planning departments to work toward development-friendly regulatory requirements.

TRANSPORTATION TO CHEBEAGUE ISLAND

Chebeague Transportation Company offers a ferry service from Cousins Island to Chebeague Island many times throughout the day according to a published schedule. Please Note: Reservations are not accepted on the ferry or the parking lots.

Ferry trips are approximately 15 minutes and originate from Stone Wharf on Chebeague Island and travel to Cousins Island Wharf on Wharf Road on Cousins Island (the mainland). For passengers traveling to Chebeague, parking is available at our Cumberland lot at Route One in Cumberland, and passengers are transported to the ferry via bus. Our bus leaves the satellite lot 30 minutes before the ferry's departure time from the mainland (at Cousins Island).

COMMUNITY GARDEN

Yarmouth Community Garden dates back to 2003, when 15 volunteers started farming a small piece of land using water drawn from a well. Since then, they have grown into one of the largest and most diversified organic community gardens in Maine. YCG is the largest community garden contributor to the Maine Harvest for Hunger program and supports the Yarmouth Community Food Pantry, Lunch Crunch, and numerous Yarmouth-based senior living facilities.

Yarmouth Community Garden is situated on a two-acre portion of Yarmouth Town land located on East Main Street at the entrance to the Frank Knight Forest. The garden has three primary areas: the one-half acre community plot, one-half acre of rental plots, and a children's garden, all supported by working beehives.

The community plot is planted, maintained, and harvested by volunteers under the direction of the community plot coordinator. A group of more than 150 volunteers raises roughly 4,000 pounds of vegetables each year, and in 2020 surpassed 50,000 total pounds since their founding. They donate this fresh, organic produce to a variety of community organizations, including Yarmouth Community Food Pantry, the Summer Lunch Crunch program for Yarmouth school-age children, local Meals on Wheels, and three senior housing complexes.

140 rental plots, under the direction of the rental plot coordinator, are each 10' x 10' in size, with excellent soil, a sunny location, a deer fence, and a convenient water supply — plus a unique opportunity to meet and learn from fellow gardeners.

The children's garden, directed by our dedicated coordinator, is a living playground made up of organic vegetables and flowers. Children ages 4 through 10 can participate in our Garden Explorers Camp, also directed by the children's garden coordinator.

MERRILL MEMORIAL LIBRARY

Joseph Edward Merrill, born in Yarmouth in 1832, attended North Yarmouth Academy and Bowdoin College. In the 1850s he entered the book business in Boston. It was his long, cherished purpose to provide Yarmouth with a public library worthy of the town and its history. Following the turn of the century, plans were made for a new town library to be built in Brick-Yard Hollow on land donated to the town by S.D. Warren and John Coombs.



The building was dedicated in 1905 as a memorial to Joseph Merrill's parents, Ezekiel Merrill and Sarah Hobart Lewis. Many books from the earlier Hillside Library were included in the original Merrill Memorial Library collection along with Joseph Merrill's personal collection.

The architect for the building was A. W. Longfellow, nephew of the poet, and senior architect for the Boston and Pittsburgh firm that designed some of the larger Carnegie library projects. At the time that Merrill Memorial library was being planned, Longfellow was working alone and designing buildings for Harvard University and Radcliffe College. This academic building style is the architectural source for Merrill Memorial Library.

In 1988, a wing was added to the rear of the original building. The addition, designed by the Portland architectural firm Stevens, Morton, Rose and Thompson, doubled the size of the library. During the 1990s, a landscape plan for the area surrounding the new entrance was created by Landscape Designer Rosemary Whitney. Development of the library gardens and a small park has continued into the new century.

The entire facility was renovated in 2014 under the guidance of Barba + Wheelock Architects. This \$2.7m renovation was undertaken with public and private funds. The building was reopened in January 2015, and serves the Yarmouth community with a variety of programs and materials and continues as the cultural anchor on Main Street.

Supported by the Town of Yarmouth and the Joseph E. Merrill Fund, the Library is a free community service. The management and control of the land and the building remains in the hands of the citizen Board of Trustees.

YARMOUTH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Yarmouth Historical Society has one of the finest local history collections in Maine. The Society exhibits this collection at the Yarmouth History Center at 118 East Elm Street, Yarmouth, Maine. At the Center, visitors can view some of the collection's thousands of objects, archives, and photographs that together help to document our local history.

The History Center offers interpretive exhibitions, educational lectures, school and community programs, local history resources, research assistance, a museum shop, and the Hamill Community Room, an event space available for rent.

Architect Scott Simons designed the Yarmouth History Center to incorporate the stone structure of the existing 1923 Water District building. Completed in 2013, the History Center's gallery, office and meeting spaces are a wonderful combination of old and new.

EDUCATION

Performance indicators of every type point to Yarmouth Schools being among the finest in New England, both on the academic scale and in terms of our co-curricular and community service offerings. Highly qualified staff, motivated students, and engaged parents are our greatest resources, complemented by significant instructional technology, community investment in education, and well-maintained, updated facilities. Over 90% of Yarmouth High School graduates pursue a post-secondary education, and Yarmouth is the only school district in Maine to have schools recognized by the U.S. Department of Education as Blue Ribbon Schools of Excellence in both 2018 (Yarmouth Elementary School) and 2019 (Yarmouth High School). Both Harrison Middle School and Yarmouth High School have been named Apple Distinguished Schools, and the Middle School is also a 2020 National Unified Champion School due to its commitment to students with special needs, and we like to say, “It all starts at Rowe School” – our outstanding school for Kindergarteners and Grade 1 students.

All four of Yarmouth’s public schools provide students with modern learning environments.



Significant expansion and renovation projects began in the fall of 2019 at each school to ensure that we have the capacity for continued excellence moving forward. Our schools offer a comprehensive academic program as well as an extracurricular program that is accessed by the majority of our students. Likewise, our teachers are recognized for prestigious awards, and present at state and national conferences.

Yarmouth is also home to one of New England's premier independent schools, North Yarmouth Academy. Established in 1814, NYA is a coeducational day school that has been educating the area's young people for over 200 years. Resembling a small college in the heart of the village, NYA's 20-acre campus includes a lower school, middle school, music building, a state-of-the-art science center, innovation lab, learning commons, language center, gymnasium, athletic fields, and NYA's Travis Roy Ice Arena. NYA offers a structured program that establishes clear standards and high expectations in an environment that emphasizes values of mutual respect, trust, and community. Academics, arts, and athletics are the cornerstones of the Academy's program.

The Lower School at NYA uses Montessori methods through the primary grades, and the kindergarten through fourth grade curriculum prepares students for middle school. WORLD'S LARGEST GLOBE – EARTHA

Eartha is the world's largest rotating and revolving globe, located within the Global Village Lobby of the Garmin office building at 2 DeLorme Drive in Yarmouth, Maine. The globe weighs approximately 5,600 pounds, and has a diameter of over 41 feet.

Open to the public for viewing Eartha Monday - Friday from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Closed holidays.



CAMP HAMMOND

Camp Hammond is a manor home built in 1889-1890 located off of Main Street. Originally landscaped by the Olmsted Brothers firm, run by the sons and successors of Frederick Law Olmsted, the designer of New York City's Central Park, the large shingle-style period home is decorated in quintessential Maine style and decor. The two-story reception hall with suspended balcony represents the finest of 19th century privileged living. It is a breathtaking crowd pleaser!

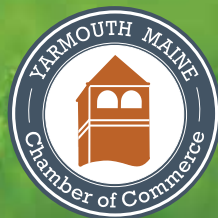

OPEN SPACES

Yarmouth is a welcoming town, inviting residents and guests to enjoy and explore its open spaces, which range from active recreation to primitive and natural areas. We ask that you enjoy all the areas we have to share while caring for the various habitats by leaving no trace. Please follow the rules for dogs in the specific parcels and clean up and carry out after your dog. Please plan ahead, most of Yarmouth's parks and open spaces do not have trash barrels and are carry-in/carry-out.

BETH CONDON PATHWAY

The Beth Condon Pathway, part of the East Coast Greenway, extends for over one mile along Route 1, from Portland Street under the East Main Street overpass and almost to the Exit 17 overpass, connecting with several other pedestrian and bicycle routes. It provides safe and convenient access to the many shops and businesses along Route 1 and Main Street.



BOSTON POST MEADOW

Boston Post Meadow is a historic field nestled in on Lone Pine Lane Extension, just off Pleasant Street. For residents in the area, it is a perfect connection to West Side Trail.

FELS-GROVES FARM PRESERVE

The Fels-Groves Farm Preserve in Yarmouth is a 55-acre parcel of mature woods and open fields. It features 1.2 miles of trails, abundant wildlife, and scenic views.

FRANK KNIGHT FOREST

The Yarmouth Community Garden on East Main Street is the entryway into this wonderful 92-acre property which features several open meadows, mature woods with large pines and steep-sided, hemlock-draped ravines. This is a great place to explore a wide diversity of habitats.

GRIST MILL PARK

This historic location looks downstream to the old mill and shipyard sites and the location of



many other early industrial and commercial endeavors. These falls were the first harnessed to power a mill site by early settlers.

LITTLE JOHN ISLAND PRESERVE

This 23-acre quiet coastal property with strictly limited and strictly enforced parking at 180 Pemasong Lane in Yarmouth provides views of Casco Bay, rocky beaches, and stately red oaks that offer perches to bald eagles and great horned owls. Owned and managed by the Royal River Conservation Trust, it is also a daytime water-access picnic site along the Royal River Water Trail.

RIVERFRONT WOODS PRESERVE

Riverfront Woods Preserve includes a combination of three parcels: Barker Preserve, Dugas Preserve, and Riverfront Woods public open space. 55 acres within this Preserve includes a small parking lot, a half a mile of shoreline along the Royal River, primitive trails, a beautiful beaver bog boardwalk and overlook, and habitats supporting beavers, deer, otters, bird species, and more. A half mile Universally Accessible trail will be created over the coming years.

ROYAL RIVER PARK

The 22-acre Royal River Park is located in the center of town and is the “jewel” in the crown of the Yarmouth park system. It features a mile-long paved walkway, waterfalls, and many scenic vistas along the Royal River. It serves as



a perfect picnic spot, as well as a great place to walk, jog, ride, roll, fish, throw a frisbee, or relax. During a few weeks of summer, the Yarmouth Summer Arts Series hosts live performances on Wednesdays that are free and open to the public. Public access for canoeing or kayaking on the upper Royal River is located across the street from the East Elm Street entrance of the Royal River Park.

PRATT’S BROOK PARK

At over 225 acres, Pratt’s Brook Park, on the northwest side of town, offers over 6 miles of hiking and cross-country skiing trails.



SANDY POINT BEACH

Yarmouth’s only public sandy beach, Sandy Point Beach is located just over the bridge to our islands. There are no lifeguards on duty. This spot is an excellent entering point for kayakers, and was the site of a shipyard in the 18th and 19th centuries. Parking is available.

SPEAR FARM ESTUARY PRESERVE

Owned and managed by the Town of Yarmouth, Spear Farm Estuary Preserve is a scenic 55-acre property with diverse habitats, ranging from stately oaks and pine forest to the open salt marshes of the Royal River estuary, and a small freshwater pond with a fringing marsh.

SWEETSIR FARM PRESERVE

The pleasant half-mile trail has solid footing except for two drainages which are crossable with long strides and stepping stones. It merges with another trail coming in from the left before paralleling the river to a small bluff and then continuing north to a set of vernal pools which harbor spring breeding populations of spotted salamanders, wood frogs, green frogs and spring peepers.

TINKER PRESERVE

The property offers natural beauty that residents frequently enjoy on short walks and picnics. A small cemetery at the far end of the property is maintained by the Cousins Island Cemetery Association.



VILLAGE RUN OPEN SPACE AND SLEDDING HILL

Just off West Main Street and Sligo Road, Magnolia Drive hosts a 7-acre parcel with a pond, sledding hill built for speed in the winter months, and a half-mile natural walking loop around the crest of the hill. A 4-car pull-off is available for guests on Magnolia Drive.

WEST SIDE TRAIL

The West Side Trail is a multi-use trail for hikers and walkers, runners, and off-road single-track bicyclists that connects neighborhoods, office parks, preserves, and public beaches. Access the trails from various trailheads. The trail is currently more than 10 miles round trip and is continuing to expand and improve each year.



There are many other active recreational and sports facilities available in Yarmouth. These include tennis and pickleball courts, five playgrounds, ball fields, basketball courts, beaches, boat launches and even a seasonal outdoor skating facility with a warming hut. MOVING TO YARMOUTH

Yarmouth is home to approximately 8,500 residents, and the community is welcoming to guests and future residents who are interested in exploring all that Yarmouth has to offer. The 10 safest cities had a 5.1 average property crime rate (U.S. 21.1) and a 0.3 average violent crime rate (U.S. 3.7).

HISTORY

The area that would become Yarmouth is in the homeland of the Abenaki Nation, part of the Wabanaki Confederacy, and has long been valued by Wabanaki communities for the natural features that define the coastal land, with its easy access to the rich resources and opportunities offered by both river and ocean. This location and its attributes quickly became sources of conflict as European colonists began to arrive in the 17th century, bringing with them conventions about land use, ownership, and trade that contrasted sharply with long-standing Wabanaki systems of stewardship and reciprocity.



Following years of successive Anglo-Wabanaki wars and the decimation of indigenous populations by diseases introduced by the colonists, settlers established the town that would become Yarmouth around 1715. The area had been named North Yarmouth by colonists in 1680 to differentiate it from Yarmouth, Massachusetts (Maine was part of Massachusetts until it gained statehood in 1820).

The territory of “ancient” North Yarmouth was large and contained a number of present-day towns that gradually split off: Harpswell was set off in 1758, Freeport in 1789, Pownal in 1808, Cumberland in 1821, and Yarmouth in 1849, leaving today’s North Yarmouth as the bearer of the name.



The Royal River has had a lasting impact on the community of Yarmouth. There are four falls along the river, and the energy produced by them led to the development of the town. Grain, lumber, fulling mills were among the early types of mills found along the river.

Later industries that utilized Yarmouth's hydropower included a cotton mill specializing in seamless grain bags and Forest Paper Company, which produced high-quality soda pulp. At its industrial peak in the early 20th century, Yarmouth was a thriving mill town employing hundreds of workers in a variety of industries.

The protected harbor at the mouth of the Royal River provided an ideal location for shipbuilding. Throughout Yarmouth's shipbuilding history, vessels were built for different kinds of trade: sloops and schooners for coastal routes, brigantines and barks for trade with the West Indies, and ships for world trade. The height of Yarmouth's shipbuilding occurred between the years 1850 and 1875. Four major shipyards built vessels during this time.

Yarmouth at the turn of the 20th century was growing and changing. The trolley system ran from Portland to Bath with stops in Yarmouth. In 1955, a bridge was built to Cousins Island to facilitate the construction of a power plant. With the bridge, residents could live on the islands year-round. In 1961, the state built Interstate 295 and Yarmouth has consistently grown in population.

Yarmouth has maintained its village characteristics primarily by maintaining a Main Street that is reminiscent of earlier days. The Yarmouth History Center at 118 East Elm Street, adjacent to the river, has an interpretive gallery that focuses on the history of the region, ranging from prehistoric archaeology to current topics, with changing exhibits, local art, and a rich slate of programs.
